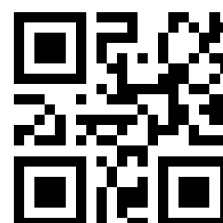

DRESS CODE

Each enclosure at Chester Racecourse adheres to a specific dress code policy. Take care to read the dress code policy in your chosen enclosure on the Plan Your Visit section of the Chester Racecourse website. You will find a detailed guide to the dress codes and some useful hints and tips on dressing for a race day. Please note that racegoers who do not adhere to the required dress code may be refused access to the Racecourse.

CHILDREN

Children under the age of 18 are admitted free of charge into all areas (except the Winning Post and Champagne Garden Enclosures), when accompanied by a full paying responsible adult. No tickets are necessary, however, children entering the County Enclosure or County Long Room will require a junior badge which can be collected from the Box Office on the day of racing. FIRST AID

There are two First Aid posts situated on the Open Course and one in the Dee Stand. The main Medical Centre is located behind the Leverhulme Stand in the Director's Car Park.

DISABLED FACILITIES

Designated disabled racegoer viewing facilities are provided in the County, Tattersalls, Paddock & Dee Stands. Disabled toilets are available in all areas and enclosures of the course. The Disabled Reception Area is located adjacent to the Weighing Room. Aids dogs to the disabled are welcome.

For racegoers who are confined to a wheelchair, parking can be arranged in the disabled parking bays at the Holiday Inn Express, which is located next to the racecourse. Other disabled patrons can park in the disabled spaces near the paddock.

GETTING HERE

Address: The Racecourse, Chester, CH1 2LY

Chester Racecourse is located in the heart of the historic city of Chester. The racecourse is easily accessible by public transport, including the rail network and road and is sign-posted from all major routes.

PARKING

Parking is available on the Open Course for £5 per vehicle and £10 per vehicle on the day. It is advisable to purchase parking in advance when booking tickets. Cash and card payments are accepted on the day on entry to the Car Park, places are issued on a first come, first served basis. Car parking for Family Funday is only available to purchase on the day.

FIRST RACE TIMES

Approximately 2pm on race days and 6pm on race evenings. Gates open at 11.30am on race days and 4.30pm on race evening.

On arriving at the racecourse, please refer to the directional signage or ask a steward to be directed to the relevant gate for entry to the course. Please be aware that there may be queues on arrival. If you are carrying a bag, it will be checked by a member of our security team. We advise only bringing a bag if it is essential. Please note, times are approximate only. Visit chester-races.com for confirmed times prior to raceday.
